**The International Summer School** on "The Problems of the New Europe" focuses each year on the most salient issues of European integration.

For the last 16 years, more than 1600 students, scholars, civil servants and young researchers met in Gorizia in order to participate to seminars, conferences and workshop activities on specific aspects of the New Europe.

**The XVII International Summer School** is organised as a combination of theoretical lectures, hands-on exercises, conferences and work-groups. Based on the observation of the New Europe and on its relation in the global geopolitical arena, the Summer School encompasses the complexity and multiple dimension of borders in the different spheres of society.

This approach calls for the development of integrated, multi-disciplinary and participatory methods and tools for cross-border cooperation. Whilst dealing with such complexity, participatory processes of active citizenship and their feed-backs to new research streams are held essential to hinder potential conflicts arising from *border-ness* and *borderless-ness*, taking into account the multiple perspectives and values intrinsic to all stakeholders. Thus, the production of knowledge and its efficient brokerage is held essential to support innovative civil society dynamics and pro-active policy formulation.

**How to apply:** Given its specific focus on CBC, the Summer School is open to all those with a stringent interest on territorial cooperation and EU enlargement and integration processes: Master students, PhD students, scholars, practitioners and civil servants.

To ensure a good tutors/participants ration, the maximum number of participants is 35.

Applications will be evaluated by the ISS 2011 scientific committee. The evaluation will be based on the following criteria: 1. congruity of applications with ISS 2011 aims and objectives; and 2. equal opportunity. In case of *ex-aequo* preference will be given to early applications.

All applicants will be informed about the evaluation results by the 8<sup>th</sup> of August 2011.
